Whitsunday Anglican School is an independent Anglican school that provides an engaging and supportive learning experience. The School charges fees associated with providing optimum educational opportunities for your student. This schedule will assist you to plan and budget for your annual students' fees. Fees cover tuition, curriculum and boarding requirements. Subject-specific levies are charged in addition to tuition and curriculum fees, for those subjects that require higher levels of resourcing. The School Board is responsible for the financial management of the School, and every endeavour is made to keep fees to a minimum.

Tuition fees include the provision of tuition, tutoring in all subjects on a formal and informal basis, the academic and pastoral care of all students, and the use of the physical environment and facilities.

Curriculum levies include the cost of printing, student diary, ID card, materials, student accident insurance and mandatory sporting, pastoral and curriculum-based activities.

Boarding fees are calculated on an annual basis and will be billed equally over four terms. Outdoor education week has not been included in the boarding fees.

Not included in these fees are activities and items that are not mandatory. These activities and items include Outdoor Education Week, non-compulsory curricular and co-curricular activities, music lessons, global excursions, Special Events (e.g. Senior Formal), boarding activities. These will be available to be accepted and paid for through Parent Lounge.

*Subject specific levies are itemised above as an annual cost but will be billed equally over four terms. These levies are to cover the additional costs associated with these specific subjects. For example, Year 11 Biology levy includes the Heron Island trip and other compulsory Biology excursions, Music levy covers the Sibelius computer program, etc.

Annual Discount

The school offers parents a discount should they wish to pay for their children's annual fees in advance of the commencement of the next academic year. Discount of 3.5% of tuition and boarding fees will be given if the annual fees are paid in full by Friday 20th January 2017.
