Re: South-East Queensland COVID-19 Lockdown Announcement

As you would be aware, the Premier has announced today that the following local government areas (LGAs) will be entering a three-day lockdown, from **4pm Saturday, 31 July 2021 until 4pm Tuesday, 3 August 2021:**

- City of Brisbane
- City of Gold Coast
- City of Ipswich
- Lockyer Valley Regional Council
- Logan City
- Moreton Bay Region
- Noosa Shire Council
- Redland City
- Scenic Rim Regional Council
- Somerset Regional Council
- Sunshine Coast Regional Council.

Anyone who has been in these local government areas is expected to stay at home, unless for an essential purpose.

If you have travelled to an aforementioned LGA

Students who have been in these LGAs are **able to come to School, only if they are children of essential workers and vulnerable persons**. If your children meet the criteria as a child of an essential worker or vulnerable person, and you have contacted the relevant Head of sub-School, then your child/ren must wear a face mask at School if they are over the age of 12. Masks may be removed when sitting down to eat, drink and while undertaking strenuous exercise. It is expected that provision of masks is the individual's responsibility.



Parents who have been to these affected areas are not permitted to enter the School's campus.
