4. Complete the Expression of Interest Form (including signed parent/guardian consents) and submit to Main School Office by **3 August**.
5. Clearance from Accounts Department
6. Students/Parents made aware (via letter/email) of their place on the expedition
7. Initial, **non-refundable**, deposit (\$500) due in order to secure a place on the expedition by **17 August**.
8. Ongoing payments by scheduled due dates

Student Contract

This Student Contract sets out the expectations of student behaviour when participating in a Global Expedition. These expeditions are valuable experiences and an opportunity to enhance and enrich your personal development and studies by first-hand experience, as well as a chance to expand your world-view. As with all Whitsunday Anglican School expeditions and exchanges, there are six basic principles that you should follow:

Responsibility
Trust
Participation
Legality
Safety
Consideration for others

I understand that trust and responsibility are the cornerstones of any school trip and that I will comply with the following principles and expectations whilst on expedition. I will accept the consequences should I infringe any of these principles. I also understand that any the deposit paid towards the trip cannot be refunded.

I agree:

1. For the expedition to be a success, I will be enthusiastic, and possess a “give it a go” attitude. I agree that the expedition is no place for a negative attitude. There may be times when I feel challenged and tired, but above all it will be rewarding and fun experience.
2. To keep an open mind, even when visiting places which may not be of enormous personal interest.
3. That there are to be no drugs, including alcohol or cigarettes, and acknowledge that this involves important legal issues as well as trust.
4. To be mindful of my own health, especially when it comes to meals, sleep and hygiene.
5. That this is a time to make friendships as well as to enjoy the company of other members of the group. I acknowledge that more intimate relationships have no place at school or on a school trip.
6. That boys are not to enter the girls’ accommodation and girls are not to enter the boys’ accommodation and any breach of this will be seen as a breach of trust.
7. To follow teacher directions, with the understanding that the instructions are given for my personal safety and benefit, or for the safety and benefit of the group of which I am part.
8. To stay as part of the group and to ensure that I am stay in the immediate supervision of teachers wherever asked or necessary.
9. To take a pro-active role in maintaining the security of the group, including the management of money and documents wherever necessary, and in avoiding unwanted attention from vendors or members of the public seeking money.

10. To act responsibly at all times.
11. To abide by the mobile phone use instructions provided by the expedition coordinator.
12. To represent the school and country in a manner which is in keeping with the idea of 'informality with dignity'. I agree to avoid loud, raucous behaviour in public and to be conscious of the need for group to not hinder other travellers.
13. To understand that travelling together can cause stresses and strains, and to recognise that others may need 'down time'.
14. I will raise any safety concerns that I have, and look out for my own safety, and the safety of others.
15. To demonstrate respect and appreciation to the teachers who have organised and supervised this trip.

I also understand that my attendance on this expedition is entirely dependent on the trust that I generate prior to departure. Significant lapses in behaviour or failure to fulfil commitments may result in me forfeiting my place in the expedition. In such a case, in consultation with the Principal and your parents, you could be sent home by the first available and safest means of transport. Any additional expense incurred would be the full responsibility of your parents.

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Parent Consent Form

I _____ (parent / guardian) give my consent for my child to participate in all the activities of the expedition and agree to delegate my authority to the teachers involved, for them to use where-ever they deem necessary.

I understand that any loss or damage to property sustained during the expedition all will be the responsibility of each student and their parents.

I also understand that the deposit paid towards the trip cannot be refunded.

I understand that my School Account must be paid up-to-date before your child's place on the expedition is offered and that all costs cannot be added to my School Account.

I understand that, as this is a Whitsunday Anglican School expedition, organised and facilitated by the School, the students are considered to be students of Whitsunday Anglican School for the duration of this expedition. The accompanying teachers may take whatever disciplinary action they may deem necessary to ensure the safety, well-being and successful conduct of the students as a group or individually.

I accept responsibility for any expenses that may be incurred due to my child's misbehaviour, which, in extreme cases, could include return airfare to Australia.

I also authorise the teachers to obtain medical assistance when deemed necessary should any accident or illness occur. I will meet any medical expenses immediately on request of the teachers, without waiting for finalisation of travel insurance claims.

To submit a medical information form for the above-named student and include details of any medical conditions or concerns my child has which may impact on their well-being, behaviour or ability to participate during the course of the tour. The form will be completed fully to the best of my knowledge and I will advise the Expedition Coordinator of any changes to my child's medical information.

If my child is required to take prescription medication on the expedition, a teacher must be informed. A letter from a doctor may be required for prescription medication for customs purposes.

I further authorise qualified practitioners to administer anaesthetic if such an eventuality arises.

I understand that, in the unlikely event that sickness meant that my child cannot return to Australia with the rest of the group, it is most likely that most of the teachers would return to Australia with the majority of the students and that one teacher would stay until return could be arranged.
