I wish to advise that the School was informed today, Wednesday 26 January, that students who attended the School on Monday 24 January have tested positive for COVID-19.

The School has conducted contact tracing and actioned a clean of the School, as per the processes advised by Mackay Public Health. These measures have taken place to ensure that the health, safety and wellbeing of staff, students and visitors are prioritised.

Students of essential workers and vulnerable children are welcome to attend School on Thursday 27 January. Upon arriving to School, they must immediately report to Mr Mick Martin, Head of Junior School, at the Junior School Office, or Mr Jamie Novosel, Deputy Principal (Pastoral/Head of Senior School), at the Senior School Office to check in.

If you or your child have any [COVID-19 symptoms](#), no matter how mild, please do not bring your child to school, call your doctor or 13HEALTH (13 43 25 84) and get tested.

If you or your child has tested positive for COVID-19, then please ensure that you are familiar with the School's advice regarding [Arrangements for students testing positive for COVID-19 or who are close contacts](#), that I communicated to families on the 14 January.
