Whitsunday Anglican School Indigenous Academic Senior Scholarships (IAS)

For new indigenous students commencing in Years 7-12

We welcome scholarship applications from indigenous students who wish to commence their education journey with one of Australia's best regional schools.

These scholarships assist Senior School students with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander heritage to attend Whitsunday Anglican School (WAS), recognise their past academic achievements, support their future endeavours and to encourage the development of Indigenous leadership.

IAS scholarships support students with the provision of a bursary of up to 50% of school fees each year and an additional \$1000 in their first year of schooling at WAS to be used for school-related expenses such as a laptop, textbooks, uniforms etc as approved by the Principal.

These scholarships will apply until the end of the student's Year 12 year provided they maintain eligibility towards the selection criteria.

IAS Selection Criteria:

- Demonstrated focus on academic success
- Support from their Indigenous community
- Personal interest in the WAS Senior School's strategic aims of internationalism, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) and innovation
- Demonstrates WAS's Core Values of Christianity, Tolerance, Excellence, Dignity and Trust
- Will contribute to the School's co-curricular program in two activities per term
- Will support the spiritual life of the School
